
Run a Mail Server inside your LAN without a dedicated IP.



- Your email is hosted outside your company (say yourcompany.com)
- You don't have any corporate internet access, means a dedicated IP, or you don't have any mail
- server such as Ms Exchange Server.
- You want to get the functionality of email server inside your network even without a dedicated IP,
- You want to send and receive emails using any fancy domain name (say **yourlocalnet.com**), but the server must translate the fancy domain name to your external hosted email domain. You want to receive email from Gmail and Yahoo to your local email address. All these functions are possible using **ids.local**
- All emails send to local users are not been send to internet, rather it directly get transferred to local user mailbox.
- Any email which send to internet, "from address" of the email will be translated to the users external primary email address. The local user can map multiple external email address to receive email to local mailbox.
